- 2. Apply for MCW Funding for a new chiller for the stadium at an estimated cost of \$84,000, with Council's portion being \$33,600 to be funded with Gas Tax.
- 3. Re-apply for MCW Funding for Bayview Water and Sewer Upgrades (AP-MCW-19413) at an estimated cost of \$1,195,607, with Council's portion being \$195,607 to be funded by borrowing the funds.
