



Dear Resident,

Town Council invites you to participate in the 2022 Spring Cleanup.

This service aims to help residents and businesses tidy up their properties. This year, Spring Cleanup will commence on May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

***Given the increased cost of fuel and contractor services, the Town will remove 2 Loader Buckets of garbage per civic address only. Please be cognisant of this as you place unwanted items out for pick-up. Additional items that do not fit within 2 loader buckets will be left behind for the resident to remove. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.***

Your garbage must be sorted into **separate piles** as follows:

|                        |  |

| <b>METALS</b>          | Hot water tanks, refrigerators, washers, dryers, bed frames, pipe, etc.                    |
| <b>ELECTRONICS</b>     | TVs, microwaves, computers, cell phones, etc.  |
| <b>HAZARDOUS WASTE</b> | Propane cylinders, paint, pesticides, oil, batteries, antifreeze, fire extinguishers, etc. |
| <b>WOOD</b>            | Wood and wood products.  |
| <b>TIRES</b>           | Removed from rims.   |
| <b>OTHER</b>           | Furniture, mattresses, plastics, glass, etc.   |

- ✓ Items **MUST NOT** be put out before May 20<sup>th</sup>.
- ✓ Be reasonable and do not put out excessive amounts of garbage per household, as only 2 loader buckets will be removed.
- ✓ Crews will only pass through each area **ONCE** to collect. Late items will not be picked up.
- ✓ Items **MUST** be sorted into piles as outlined above. If it's not sorted, it will not be picked up.
- ✓ All loose items must be in either clear plastic bags or containers/boxes weighing no more than 50 lbs. Dark bags will not be picked up.
- ✓ All broken glass must be clearly marked and properly contained.
- ✓ All nails should be removed or bent into wood completely on wood and wood products.
- ✓ Tires should be separated from rims.
- ✓ The following items **WILL NOT** be collected: yard waste (trees, tree branches), car wrecks, construction waste (material from renovated or demolished buildings, shingles, gyproc, windows, ceramic tile, etc.), fishing gear (crab pots, nets, etc.), dark garbage bags.
